The Embassy of Nepal, Kuala Lumpur hosted a reception to celebrate the National Day and the Constitution Day on 19 September 2024. The Honourable Dato' Sri Abdul Rahman bin Haji Mohamad, Deputy Minister of Human Resources of Malaysia participated in the event as the Guest of Honour.

Speaking on the occasion, Chargé d'Affaires' a.i. Ms. Mudita Bajracharya stated that the Constitution of Nepal 2015, which transformed the political landscape of the country into the Federal Democratic Republic, guarantees equality, freedom, dignity and human rights of citizens.

Furthermore, addressing the guests, she extended best wishes and warm greetings to the Nepali community living in Malaysia and Malaysian friends of Nepal and stated that both are valuable assets that Nepal has in Malaysia.

Chargé d'Affaires' a.i mentioned about Nepal's historical link to Malaysia dating back to the 1950s, during its founding period, by way of the contribution of Nepali Gurkha soldiers under the British in maintaining peace and stability in Malaysia.
